Days Inn Folks:

1. Head northeast toward S Pulliam Dr (154 ft.)
2. Turn left onto S Pulliam Dr About 1 min (0.3 miles)
3. Turn left onto John Wesley Powell Blvd About 1 min (0.3 miles)
4. Turn right to merge onto I-17 N toward Arizona 89A/Flagstaff About 4 mins (2.7 miles)
5. Take exit 340B to merge onto I-40 W toward Los Angeles About 44 mins (49.1 miles)
6. Take exit 146 for I-40 BUS/AZ-89 S toward Ash Fork/Prescott About 1 min (0.6 miles)
7. Turn left onto AZ-89 S/Interstate 40 Business Loop E (signs for Arizona 89 S/Prescott)
Continue to follow AZ-89 S About 39 mins (35.9 miles)
8. Turn right onto Fletcher Ct Destination will be on the left (0.1 miles)

Days Inn Folks:

1. Head east on Fletcher Ct toward AZ-89 N (0.1 miles)
2. Turn left onto AZ-89 About 7 mins (4.4 miles)
3. Turn left onto E Rd 5 N About 8 mins (2.9 miles)
4. Turn right onto N Yuma Dr About 3 mins (1.1 miles)
5. Continue onto Sky Hawk Dr (0.2 miles)
6. Turn right onto W Nighthawk Rd/T-Bone Rd About 1 min (0.3 miles)
